By application accepted for filing February 19, 1997, Whiting, Bayard & Morris Coach Service, Inc., a Virginia corporation trading as Professional Tours, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one motorcoach. Applicant's proposed tariff contains mileage and hourly group charter rates.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 12, 1997, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 2, 1997, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 2, 1997, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Carlton Whiting, 4301 Stockton Street, Richmond, VA 23224-3344.
