By application accepted for filing March 6, 1997, All America Bus & Limousine Service, Inc., a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one minibus. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly charter rate and airport transfer rates.


Applicant is under common control with America Limousine Service, Inc., which operates limousines in Virginia under a certificate from the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles. Applicant will be directed to file a statement describing the effects of common control on competition and on the interests of affected employees.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 1, 1997, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 22, 1997, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 1, 1996, an original and four copies of a statement describing the effects of common control on competition and on the interests of affected employees.
4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 22, 1997, and that copies must be served on applicant's attorney, M. Brooks Savage, Esquire, 1101-17th Street, N.W., Suite 405, Washington, DC 20036.
