
By application accepted for filing February 26, 1997, Ideal Transportation Services, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Notice of this application was served March 3, 1997, in Order No. 5034, and applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper no later than March 14, 1997. On March 25, 1997, applicant advised the Commission that said notice was not timely published. Accordingly, a new publication deadline shall be established.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 8, 1997, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 29, 1997, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 29, 1997, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Dr. Denise Braxtonbrown-Smith, 1938-4th Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20001.
