This proceeding was initiated on April 23, 1997, in Order No. 5062, for the purpose of investigating the failure of Executive Mobile Services, Inc., to file its annual report for 1996. The order directed respondent to file its annual report within thirty days. The order also directed respondent to pay a civil forfeiture of \$100, or show good cause why a forfeiture should not be assessed, within the same thirty-day period. The order gave respondent fifteen days to file a request for oral hearing, in the alternative.


Respondent failed to respond by the May 23 deadline, and, pursuant to Order No. 5062, Certificate No. 161 was automatically suspended and respondent had thirty days to show good cause why Certificate No. 161 should not be revoked.

On June 2, 1997, respondent filed its annual report for 1996 and paid the \$100 forfeiture.

For good cause shown, the suspension shall be lifted and this proceeding terminated.
