By application filed June 3, 1997, Junior's Enterprises, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff, Exhibit D, contains various hourly, per capita, and transfer rates, including rates for transportation in vehicles with seating capacities in excess of 15 persons, including the driver. Applicant will be directed to file either an amended Exhibit D omitting any reference to vehicles with seating capacities in excess of 15 persons, including the driver, or an amended page 4 of the application indicating an intention to operate vehicles with seating capacities of 16 or more persons, including the driver.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 23, 1997, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 14, 1997, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 23, 1997, an original and four copies of either an amended Exhibit D omitting any reference to vehicles with seating capacities in excess of 15 persons, including the driver, or an amended page 4 of the application indicating an intention to operate vehicles with seating capacities of 16 or more persons, including the driver.
4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 14, 1997, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Horace C. Green, Jr., 4111 Kilbourne Drive, Fort Washington, MD 20744.
