By application filed June 20, 1997, Guyana Coach, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one motorcoach. Applicant's proposed tariff, Exhibit D, contains an airport transfer rate and a four-hour minimum charge for charter service. The hourly rate for charter service in excess of four hours is missing. Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit D specifying the hourly rate for charter service in excess of the four-hour minimum.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than July 7, 1997, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 28, 1997, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 7, 1996, an original and four copies of an amended Exhibit D specifying the hourly rate for charter service in excess of the four-hour minimum.
4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 28, 1997, and that copies must be served on applicant's board secretary, Teresa Charles, 571 Wilson Bridge Drive, Oxon Hill, MD 20745.
