By application accepted for filing December 19, 1997, Limo. Pleasures, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one limousine. Applicant's proposed tariff contains airport transfer rates and hourly charter rates with minimum charges.

Applicant's place of business is in Huntingtown, MD, which is outside the Metropolitan District. In accordance with Commission Regulation No. 68, applicant will be directed to designate, for the purpose of receiving service of process, an agent residing in the Metropolitan District.


This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than January 9, 1998, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than January 30, 1998, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than January 30, 1998, an original and four copies of a statement designating, for the purpose of receiving service of process, an agent residing in the Metropolitan District.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is January 30, 1998, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Larry R. Stallings, Jr., 1820 Ponds Wood Road, Huntingtown, MD 20639.
