By application filed January 6, 1998, Just Class LLC, a Maryland limited liability company, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one 49-passenger motorcoach. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly charter rate and an optional mileage rate.


Applicant's place of business is in Baltimore, MD, which is outside the Metropolitan District. In accordance with Commission Regulation No. 68, applicant will be directed to designate, for the purpose of receiving service of process, an agent residing in the Metropolitan District.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 3, 1998, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 24, 1998, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 24, 1998, an original and four copies of a statement designating, for the purpose of receiving service of process, an agent residing in the Metropolitan District.
4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is February 24, 1998, and that copies must be served on applicant's attorney, Christopher S. Young, Esquire, 3440 Ellicott Center Drive, #103, Ellicott City, MD 21043.
