By application accepted for filing February 11, 1998, Med-Care Transportation Corporation, a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

Exhibit A to the application is incomplete. Applicant will be directed to file an amended list of principal shareholders indicating their respective holdings and copies of applicant's articles of incorporation.


This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 27, 1998, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 20, 1998, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 27, 1998, an original and four copies of an amended list of principal shareholders indicating their respective holdings.
4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 27, 1998, an original and four copies of applicant's articles of incorporation.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is March 20, 1998, and that copies must be served on applicant's CEO, Mr. Ahmed E. Elrayah, P.O. Box 1274, Falls Church, VA 22041.
