By application accepted for filing February 25, 1998, Ken-Dan Transportation Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington-Dulles International Airports, plus per capita mileage rates for transportation between other points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant's compliance fitness evidence, Part II, Item No. 11 of the application, is incomplete. Applicant will be directed file an amended page 5 of the application form with Item No. 11 completed.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 11, 1998, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 1, 1998, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 11, 1998, an original and four copies of an amended page 5 of the application form with Item No. 11 completed.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 1, 1998, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Mr. Adamu Lemu, 7604 Marietta Lane, College Park, MD 20740.
