
This investigation was initiated on April 7, 1998, pursuant to Order No. 5308 to determine whether respondents violated Article XI, Section 11, and/or Article XII, Section 3, by transferring a substantial part of respondent Adetunji's assets to the respondent corporation without Commission approval. A check drawn on the account of "Vision Transport Inc." in payment of Adetunji's WMATC annual fee for 1998 indicated that this had occurred. Respondents were given until May 7 to file a transfer application or show cause why a civil forfeiture should not be assessed. The deadline was extended to May 25 by Order No. 5331.

On May 22, respondents provided the Commission with a copy of a notice from the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation stating that articles of dissolution for Vision Transport, Inc., were "received and approved for record on May 22, 1998."

For good cause shown, no civil forfeiture shall be assessed. Accordingly, this proceeding is terminated as to the above-captioned respondents.
