

These proceedings were initiated on May 1, 1998, in Orders Nos. 5324 and 5325 as a result of respondent's failure to timely pay a \$100 annual fee for 1998 and file an annual report for 1997. Order No. 5324 granted respondent thirty days to file the annual report and either pay a civil forfeiture of \$100 or show cause why a civil forfeiture should not be assessed. Order No. 5325 granted respondent thirty days to pay the annual fee and a \$100 civil forfeiture.

Respondent failed to respond by the May 31 deadline. As a result, Certificate No. 327 was automatically suspended pursuant to said orders. Because respondent has since filed its annual report for 1997, paid its annual fee for 1998, and paid the \$200 civil forfeiture, the suspension shall be lifted and this proceeding terminated.
