These proceedings were initiated on May 1, 1998, in Order Nos. 5324 and 5325 as a result of respondent's failure to timely pay a \$100 annual fee for 1998 and file an annual report for 1997. Order No. 5324 granted respondent thirty days to file the annual report and either pay a civil forfeiture of \$100 or show cause why a civil forfeiture should not be assessed. Order No. 5325 granted respondent thirty days to pay the annual fee and a \$100 civil forfeiture.

The orders further provided that upon respondent's failure to timely comply, Certificate No. 231 would be automatically suspended and respondent would have until June 30 to show cause why Certificate No. 231 should not be revoked. Respondent failed to comply by May 31 and failed to show cause by June 30.

On July 8, 1998, however, respondent filed its annual report, paid its \$100 annual fee and paid the \$200 combined forfeiture.

In consideration of the foregoing, the show cause deadline is hereby extended through July 8, the suspension of Certificate No. 231 is hereby lifted, and this consolidated proceeding is hereby terminated.
