By application accepted for filing August 17, 1998, Haymarket Transportation, Inc., a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Although applicant seeks Commission approval to obtain Certificate No. 277 from George Mouratidis, trading as Haymarket Transportation, that certificate has been revoked,¹ and the deadline for filing an application for reconsideration has expired.² Consequently, the application is deemed one to obtain a new certificate.³

Applicant proposes commencing operations with eleven vehicles. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly charter rates with minimum charges.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 31, 1998, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 21, 1998, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is September 21, 1998, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, George Mouratidis, 14416 Shelter Lane, Haymarket, VA 20169.
