Case No. AP-98-39

By application accepted for filing September 10, 1998, Fairfax Coach Lines, Inc., a Virginia corporation trading as Fairfax Coach, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with four minibuses.

Applicant's proposed tariff, Exhibit D, contains hourly charter rates with minimum charges for service in minibuses. Applicant's proposed tariff also contains rates for service in full size buses, sedans, vans and limousines. Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit C identifying the buses, sedans, vans and limousines to be operated by applicant and/or an amended Exhibit D omitting rates for service in vehicles to be operated by someone else.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than September 21, 1998, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.


2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 13, 1998, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 21, 1998, an original and four copies of an amended Exhibit C identifying the buses, sedans, vans and limousines to be operated by applicant and/or an amended Exhibit D omitting rates for service in vehicles to be operated by someone else.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is October 13, 1998, and that copies must be served on applicant's
