By application filed September 28, 1998, Jo-ee Ventures Inc., a Maryland corporation trading as Jo-ee Transportation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation between Montgomery and Prince George's Counties, Maryland, on the one hand, and Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports, on the other, plus per capita mileage rates for transportation between other points in the Metropolitan District.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 12, 1998, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 2, 1998, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 2, 1998, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Joseph Njiaju, 12138 Skip Jack Drive, Germantown, MD 20874.
