By application accepted for filing September 29, 1998, Byron Lamont McDade, trading as Family Transportation, (McDade), WMATC Carrier No. 352, and Family Transportation, Inc., (FTI or transferee), a District of Columbia corporation, (collectively applicants), seek Commission approval transfer Certificate of Authority No. 352 from McDade to FTI. McDade is an officer and sole shareholder of FTI.

FTI proposes to commence operations with two vans. FTI's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

Article XI, Section 11(a), of the Compact governs the transfer of a certificate of authority to a corporation in which this certificate holder has a controlling interest.<sup>1</sup> A transfer of this nature raises fitness issues only.<sup>2</sup>

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether transferee is fit.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicants shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 16, 1998, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicants shall file with the Commission, no later than November 6, 1998, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.



3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 6, 1998, and that copies must be served on transferee's president, Byron Lamont McDade, 535 Shepherd Street, N.W.. Washington, DC 20011.
