By application filed November 2, 1998, Services International, Inc., a Virginia corporation trading as S.I. Limousine and Travel, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant has also applied for temporary authority in Case No. AP-98-48.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with three vehicles. Applicant's proposed tariff, Exhibit D, contains hourly rates and mileage rates, but no explanation of when one type of rate applies and not the other. Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit D with an explanation of when its rates apply.


This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 16, 1998, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 7, 1998, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 16, 1998, an original and four copies of an amended Exhibit D explaining when hourly rates apply and when mileage rates apply.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is December 7, 1998, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Adil Salih, 8321 Old Courthouse Road, Suite 150, Vienna, VA 22182.
