By application accepted for filing February 18, 1999, Yinka Adeyefa, a sole proprietor trading as Ardwork Airport Shuttle, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. The van is owned by applicant and co-owned by Lawrence O. Adetunji, WMATC Carrier No. 394. Further, the vehicle registration address is Mr. Adetunji's, not applicant's. Applicant will be directed to file a written statement describing Mr. Adetunji's interest in applicant's vehicle and explaining why applicant should not be ordered to terminate Mr. Adetunji's interest.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 5, 1999, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 26, 1999, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 5, 1999, an original and four copies of a written statement describing Lawrence Adetunji's interest in applicant's vehicle and explaining why applicant should not be ordered to terminate Mr. Adetunji's interest.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is March 26, 1999, and that copies must be served on applicant at 1508 Columbia Avenue, Cheverly, MD 20785.
