By application filed March 5, 1999, All Events Shuttle Service, Inc., a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant is under common control with EZS, Incorporated, a Virginia corporation trading as Majestic Limousine. EZS operates under a limousine and executive sedan permit from the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with three minibuses. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly charter rate with a minimum charge.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 23, 1999, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 13, 1999, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 13, 1999, and that copies must be served on applicant's attorney, M. Brooks Savage, Jr., Esquire, 1101-17th Street, N.W., Suite 405, Washington, DC 20036.
