This matter is before the Commission on the petition to intervene of Washington Shuttle, Inc., trading as SuperShuttle, WMATC Carrier No. 369. The petition is accompanied by a motion to consolidate this proceeding with Case No. MP-99-11, concerning the application of Malek Investment of Virginia, Inc., for a certificate of authority. Petitioner opposes both the application and Malek of Virginia's motion to withdraw the application without prejudice.


The petition to intervene, motion to consolidate, and objection to withdrawal were all filed on April 26. Under the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Malek of Virginia has five days to reply to the objection, and respondents have seven days to reply to the petition and motion -- making the respective deadlines May 3 and May 5.

Respondents have timely requested an extension of both deadlines to May 15 to permit coordination of their replies.

Under Commission Rule No. 7-05, the deadlines in question may be extended for good cause shown. Inasmuch as petitioner's various April 26 filings are inter-linked, respondents' request to extend the deadlines shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that respondents shall file on or before May 15, 1999, their reply or replies to petitioner's April 26 filings.
