By application accepted for filing June 3, 1999, Elias Keros Kebede, a sole proprietor trading as Eagle Connection, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation between the District of Columbia and Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports, as well as mileage rates for transportation between other points in the Metropolitan District.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 21, 1999, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 12, 1999, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 12, 1999, and that copies must be served on applicant's attorney Aragaw Mehari at 1010 Vermont Avenue, N.W., #618, Washington, DC 20005.
