By application accepted for filing July 20, 1999, District of Columbia Arc, Inc., a nonprofit, District of Columbia corporation trading as DC ARC, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with eleven vehicles. Applicant proposes several contract tariffs for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 9, 1999, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 30, 1999, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 30, 1999, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Susan Whitlock, Director, Administrative Services, 900 Varnum Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20017.
