By application accepted for filing September 7, 1999, Jonathan D. Morris, a sole proprietor trading as Big John Shuttle, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports and rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than September 23, 1999, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 14, 1999, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is October 14, 1999, and that copies must be served on applicant at 7414 Larne Lane, Lorton, VA 22079.
