Case No. AP-99-69

By application filed September 30, 1999, Apex Transportation Inc., a District of Columbia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program, plus hourly rates and per capita rates for non-Medicaid transportation.

The application states that Apex has no control relationship with another carrier, but the Commission's records indicate that Apex's secretary-treasurer, Bobby Bradsher, Sr., is a shareholder, director and vice president of WMATC Carrier No. 387, B&B Transportation Service, Inc. Applicant will be directed to file either a notarized affidavit from Bobby Bradsher, Sr., stating he has severed all ties with Carrier No. 387, or if Mr. Bradsher has not severed all ties with Carrier No. 387, an Exhibit G describing the effect of common control on competition and employees.


This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 18, 1999, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 8, 1999, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 18, 1999, an original and four copies of either a notarized affidavit from Bobby Bradsher, Sr., stating he has severed all ties with Carrier No. 387, or if Mr. Bradsher has not severed all ties with Carrier No. 387, an Exhibit G describing the effect of common control on competition and employees.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 8, 1999, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, James Bradsher, 15 Danbury Street, S.E., #4, Washington, DC 20032.
