By application accepted for filing January 3, 2000, Tyson's Charters, a Maryland partnership, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one motorcoach. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly rate with a minimum charge.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 2, 2000, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 23, 2000, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is February 23, 2000, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Albert Tyson, Jr., 9405 Sierra Street, Silver Spring, MD 20903.
