On January 1, 2000, the certificate of insurance on file for Diplomat Limousine and Livery Service, Inc., expired at 12:01 a.m., triggering the invalidation and automatic suspension of Certificate No. 176 under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Regulation No. 58-02.

On January 3, 2000, the Commission issued Order No. 5778, directing respondent to file an appropriate certificate of insurance within 30 days or show cause why Certificate No. 176 should not be revoked.

On January 4, 2000, respondent filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 176.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder.

The application shall be granted.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 176, issued to Diplomat Limousine and Livery Service, Inc., is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That applicant is hereby directed to remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.

3. That applicant is hereby directed to file within 30 days from the date of this order a notarized affidavit verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph.
