The certificate of insurance on file for Mohammed E. Ibrahim, trading as Get Well Transit, was cancelled effective 12:01 a.m. on February 2, 2000, triggering the invalidation and automatic suspension of Certificate No. 477 under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Regulation No. 58-02.

That same day the Commission issued Order No. 5802 and therein directed respondent to file an appropriate certificate of insurance within 30 days or show cause why Certificate No. 477 should not be revoked.

On February 16, 2000, respondent filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 477.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder.

The application shall be granted.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 477, issued to Mohammed E. Ibrahim, trading as Get Well Transit, is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That applicant is hereby directed to remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.

3. That applicant is hereby directed to file within 30 days from the date of this order a notarized affidavit verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph.
