By application filed May 9, 2000, AA TransCare, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program and rates for non-Medicaid transportation.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 2, 2000, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 23, 2000, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 23, 2000, and that copies must be served on applicant's attorney, Jeremy Kahn, Esquire, 1730 Rhode Island Avenue, N.W., Suite 810, Washington, DC 20036.
