Notice of this application was served on May 19, 2000, in Order No. 5885. Applicant was directed to publish further notice in "a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District."

On June 1, 2000, applicant filed an affidavit attesting to publication of the required notice in the "FAIRFAX, ALEXANDRIA, ARLINGTON" editions of The Journal Newspapers. Publication in The Journal Newspapers does not meet the requirement to publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District.<sup>1</sup>


The Washington Afro-American, the Washington Post and the Washington Times are deemed to be newspapers of general circulation in the Metropolitan District.<sup>2</sup>

Applicant will be directed to republish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, and a new protest deadline will be established.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 16, 2000, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 7, 2000, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 7, 2000, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Thomas Saporito, P.O. Box 1051, Vienna, VA 22183.
