By application accepted for filing June 1, 2000, Central African Women Empowerment Organization Corp., a Maryland corporation trading as CAWEO Transportation Services, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with three vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation funded by Medicaid and rates for transportation not funded by Medicaid.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 20, 2000, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 11, 2000, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 11, 2000, and that copies must be served on applicant's vice president, Emma Osong, 13509 Silent Lake Drive, Clarksville, MD 21029.
