On July 21, 2000, the Commission issued notice that it was revoking respondent's certificate of insurance thirty days hence. The notice gave respondent until August 20 to replace the existing certificate of insurance with a new one, present its revenue vehicles for inspection by Commission staff, submit a list of vehicles insured in respondent's name, and show cause why a vehicle belonging to respondent's president should not be insured under a policy issued in respondent's name.


The August 20 deadline was subsequently extended to September 5 by Order No. 5967, served August 15. When it became clear that an additional extension of time would be necessary, respondent requested clarification from staff as to whether a written request was necessary, and staff advised respondent that as long as respondent complied with the Commission's investigation no suspension order would be issued for respondent's failure to respond by September 5.

A list of vehicles insured in respondent's name, including the vehicle owned by respondent's president, was submitted on September 11. An acceptable WMATC Certificate of Insurance & Policy Endorsement was filed on September 18. Respondent's revenue vehicles passed inspection on September 20.

Accordingly, this proceeding is terminated.
