By application accepted for filing November 13, 2000, Adeyemi T. Okiji, a sole proprietor trading as Aduras Transportation Services, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports and rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 27, 2000, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 18, 2000, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is December 18, 2000, and that copies must be served on applicant at 5835 Harness Court, Columbia, MD 21044.
