On December 11, 2000, IONA Senior Services filed two original WMATC certificates of insurance dated November 30, 2000. One certificate shows \$1 million in primary coverage. The other shows \$5 million in excess coverage. Both show the same Philadelphia Insurance Company policy number, PHPG124591.

On December 26, 2000, the Commission received facsimiles of two more WMATC certificates of insurance for IONA. The fax versions show the same amounts of coverage as the originals received December 11, but the fax versions are unsigned, undated and show an excess policy number of PHUM106263.


Under Regulation No. 58-09, the Commission may, upon thirty (30) days' notice, revoke its approval of any certificate of insurance if, in the judgment of the Commission, such security does not comply with the Commission's regulations or for any reason fails to provide satisfactory or adequate protection for the public. Accordingly, we shall revoke respondent's original \$5 million excess certificate of insurance dated November 30, 2000. The revocation shall take effect thirty days from the date of this order. Respondent shall have until then to file a newly executed original showing the correct policy number.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent's \$5 million excess certificate of insurance is hereby revoked, effective thirty days from the date of this order.
2. That respondent shall have thirty days from the date of this order to file a newly executed WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement showing the correct excess coverage policy number.
3. That unless respondent complies with the requirements of this order within the time allowed, Certificate of Authority No. 444 shall be invalid and stand automatically suspended pursuant to Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58-02 and shall be subject to immediate revocation without further proceedings.

4. That respondent may file within fifteen days from the date of this order a request for oral hearing, indicating the grounds for the request, describing the evidence to be adduced and explaining why such evidence cannot be adduced without an oral hearing.
