The certificates of insurance on file for U.S. Trans Logistics, Inc., were cancelled effective 12:01 a.m. on January 18, 2001, triggering the invalidation and automatic suspension of Certificate No. 530 under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58-02.

The Commission issued Order No. 6100 on January 19 and therein directed respondent to file appropriate certificates of insurance within 30 days or show cause why Certificate No. 530 should not be revoked.

On February 1, 2001, respondent filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 530.


The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder.

The application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 530 is hereby terminated, effective this date.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:
 - a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 530 to the Commission.
