This investigation was initiated on January 11, 2001, in Order No. 6085 (initial order) for the purpose of determining whether Certificate of Authority No. 525 shall be revoked for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact and regulations thereunder.

The Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 7(f), directs each person holding a certificate of authority to comply with the Commission's insurance regulations. Commission Regulation No. 58-01 requires each carrier to maintain on file with the Commission an effective certificate of insurance showing the minimum liability coverage prescribed by Regulation No. 58-03. The prescribed minimum for respondent is \$1.5 million.

Respondent's certificates of insurance expired at 12:01 a.m. on January 10, 2001, triggering the invalidation and automatic suspension of its certificate of authority under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Regulation No. 58-02. Respondent was directed to file appropriate replacement certificates of insurance within thirty days or show good cause why its certificate of authority should not be revoked.

Respondent failed to meet the February 9 deadline. Not until March 5 did respondent file a replacement certificate of insurance. Moreover, the replacement certificate showed less than the minimum coverage required by Regulation No. 58-03.


Respondent's certificate of authority shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact, the regulations thereunder and the initial order in this proceeding.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 525 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:

- a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 525 to the Commission.
