By application accepted for filing April 5, 2001, Almighty Time Investments Incorporated, a Maryland corporation trading as Almighty Courier - Transport Services, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

Applicant's compliance fitness evidence, Part II, Item No. 11 of the application, is incomplete. Applicant will be directed file an amended page 5 of the application form with Item No. 11 completed.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 25, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 16, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is May 16, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Irikefe Arthur Udugba, P.O. Box 1797, Landover, MD 20785.
