On April 3, 2001, respondent filed his annual report for 2000 showing a new address for his principal place of business. That same day, respondent filed a certificate of insurance with the new address. Mail sent recently to respondent at that address was returned by the U.S. Postal Service marked not deliverable as addressed.

Commission Regulation No. 68 requires each carrier to keep the address of its principal place of business on file with the Commission at all times. An insurance certificate filed with the Commission must display a valid address for the carrier.¹ Under Regulation No. 58-09, the Commission may, upon thirty (30) days' notice, revoke its approval of any certificate of insurance if, in the judgment of the Commission, such security does not comply with the Commission's regulations or for any reason fails to provide satisfactory or adequate protection for the public.

We will revoke respondent's certificate of insurance, effective thirty days from the date of this order. Respondent shall have until then to file a new certificate of insurance and written proof that the address reflected on the new certificate is in fact respondent's address.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent's certificate of insurance is hereby revoked, effective thirty days from the date of this order.

2. That respondent shall have thirty days from the date of this order to file a new WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement, plus written proof that the address reflected on the new certificate is in fact respondent's address.

3. That unless respondent complies with the requirements of this order within the time allowed, Certificate of Authority No. 532 shall be invalid and stand automatically suspended pursuant to Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58-02 and shall be subject to immediate revocation without further proceedings.

4. That respondent may file within fifteen days from the date of this order a request for oral hearing, indicating the grounds for the request, describing the evidence to be adduced and explaining why such evidence cannot be adduced without an oral hearing.
