Under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58-02, a carrier's certificate of authority is deemed invalid and automatically suspended upon failure to maintain an effective insurance certificate on file with the Commission. The insurance certificates on file for respondent expired May 1, 2001, and have not been replaced. Certificate of Authority No. 553, therefore, is invalid and suspended.

Pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, respondent shall have thirty days to file effective insurance certificates or show cause why Certificate No. 553 should not be revoked.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent is hereby directed to cease and desist from conducting transportation subject to the Compact, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That respondent is directed to file an effective certificate of insurance within thirty days or show good cause why its certificate of authority should not be revoked.

3. That respondent may file within 15 days from the date of this order a request for oral hearing, specifying the grounds for the request, describing the evidence to be adduced and explaining why such evidence cannot be adduced without an oral hearing.
