
Pursuant to Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58-02, a WMATC certificate of authority is not valid unless an effective certificate of insurance is on file with the Commission. The certificates of insurance on file for respondent expired March 31, 2001. Order No. 6172, issued in this proceeding on April 3, 2001, directed respondent to file effective insurance certificates within thirty days or show good cause why respondent's certificate of authority should not be revoked. To date, respondent has neither filed effective insurance certificates nor shown good cause why Certificate No. 520 should not be revoked.

Certificate No. 520 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact, the regulations thereunder and the initial order in this proceeding.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 520 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 520 to the Commission.
