By application accepted for filing May 24, 2001, Akeem Akinbo Ganiyu, trading as AMS-SEG Transportation (Ganiyu), WMATC Carrier No. 557, and Rock of Ages, Incorporated, a Maryland corporation trading as Winners Shuttle (Winners) (collectively applicants), seek Commission approval to transfer Certificate of Authority No. 557 from Ganiyu to Winners. Ganiyu is an officer of Winners.

Winners proposes commencing operations with one van. Winners' proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

Article XI, Section 11(a), of the Compact governs the transfer of assets, including a certificate of authority, by an unincorporated WMATC carrier in exchange for a controlling interest in a newly formed corporation.¹ A transfer of this nature raises fitness issues only.²

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether transferee is fit.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicants shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 20, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.


2. That applicants shall file with the Commission, no later than July 11, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.



3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 11, 2001, and that copies must be served on Winners' president, Akeem Akinbo Ganiyu, 11440 Stewart Lane, #C2, Silver Spring, MD 20904.
