By application accepted for filing June 11, 2001, Herald Options Inc., a Maryland corporation trading as Federal Airport Shuttle, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington-Dulles International Airports, plus an hourly rate for transportation between other points in the Metropolitan District.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than July 13, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 3, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 3, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Nii Kpani-Addy, 17504 Towne Crest Drive, Gaithersburg, MD 20877.
