By application accepted for filing July 18, 2001, Victory Transportation Services, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly rate with a minimum charge, and a per capita fare with an excess mileage rate, for door-to-door service.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 6, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 27, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 27, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Christine Valentine, 2804 Foxglove Way, Springdale, MD 20774.
