By application accepted for filing July 26, 2001, Super Sedan & Limousine Service Incorporated, a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one motorcoach. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly charter rate.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 17, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 7, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is September 7, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Nicolas Dabbour, 5055 Seminary Road, #1405, Alexandria, VA 22311.
