By application accepted for filing August 6, 2001, LAM Associates, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation, seeks temporary authority to conduct shuttle service between points in the Metropolitan District as specified in two contracts with the General Services Administration and one contract with the Federal Aviation Administration.¹ Applicant proposes commencing operations with four vans.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 13(a), the Commission may grant temporary authority if there is an immediate need for service that is not available. Under Regulation No. 54-06(a), a temporary authority applicant must demonstrate fitness. This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether there is an immediate need for service that is not available.


One of applicant's proposed GSA contract tariffs contains an incomplete description of shuttle service requirements. Applicant will be directed to file a complete proposal.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 29, 2001, an original and four copies of a complete proposed contract tariff for service under GSA Contract No. GS-10F-0200J.

2. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 29, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Overton J. Gillis, Jr., 8245 Boone Blvd., #200, Vienna, VA 22182.
