By application accepted for filing August 13, 2001, Bellah Reliable Transport, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant proposes to provide transportation under the Medicaid programs of Montgomery County and Prince George's County, Maryland.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 29, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 19, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is September 19, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's vice president, Ivo Ngosong, 6100 Breezewood Drive, #303, Greenbelt, MD 20770.
