By application accepted for filing October 3, 2001, Achu Services Group LLC, a District of Columbia limited liability company trading as Achu Transportation Unlimited, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van and one sedan. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for Medicaid transportation and non-Medicaid transportation.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 5, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 26, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 26, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Odel Achu, 6733 New Hampshire Avenue, #109, Takoma Park, MD 20912.
