By application filed October 4, 2001, Lt. Joseph P. Kennedy Institute, Inc., a nonprofit District of Columbia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant's proposed contract tariffs contain rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 5, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 26, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 26, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's director of administrative services, Tamara A. Rippeon, 801 Buchanan Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20017.
