By application accepted for filing October 16, 2001, Mohamed Abdelaziz Gomaa, a sole proprietor, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for Medicaid transportation and rates for non-Medicaid transportation, including rates for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 6, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 27, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 27, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's attorney, Joel C. Weingarten, Esquire, 1616 H Street, N.W., Suite 902, Washington, DC 20006.
