By application accepted for filing October 23, 2001, Skyhawk Logistics, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant held WMATC Certificate of Authority No. 406 from February 26, 1998, to July 19, 2001, when it was revoked for applicant's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact and regulations thereunder.¹

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an annual rate for shuttle service under a contract with the U.S. Department of Transportation.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 30, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 21, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is December 21, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, O. Jimmy Ogunniyi, 1110 Bonifant Street, Suite 501, Silver Spring, MD 20910.
